

Open Society Foundations Presidential Fellowship

2013 Application Procedure

Funded by the Open Society Foundations (“OSF”), the OSF Presidential Fellowship, permits Fellows to spend one year in residence at OSF in New York City. Fellows pursue work related to human rights, good governance, and justice through a one-year residence within the Office of the President at OSF.

In 2013, OSF Presidential Fellowships will be awarded to three students graduating from an accredited U.S. law, public policy, or business school. Fellows are selected for their scholarship, leadership, and commitment to continued practice in the fields of nonprofit management, human rights, good governance, and justice.

Attached are the materials necessary to complete a Fellowship application. All application materials are due by 1:00 p.m. on Friday, March 29, 2013. Finalists will be notified after April 12, 2013 and interviews will be conducted during the week of April 22, 2013.
